

RECREATION FIELD COMMITTEE - TERMS OF REFERENCE

To list and consider the suitability of a number of sites that might be made available for the provision of a recreation area for the residents of Walford.

Whilst the Parish Plan emphasises the need for a children's playground and play area, the potential for extra facilities for each age group should be considered according to the size of the site recommended.

- i. As part of the project, any site recommended must be able to contain a play area for children with each increase in site size offering the possibilities of providing leisure and wider recreational activities for a larger spectrum of age groups.
- ii. The suitability of any site will need to be looked at in relation to access, parking, the surrounding area, roads and traffic and the effect of all these in general on safety whether children are accompanied or not.
- iii. Any comments or objections from neighbouring residents, property owners and adjacent businesses, must be considered.
- iv. The potential costing of and funding for any site proposals will be discussed in full and agreed by the Recreation Committee, before being passed to the Parish Council for general approval and a recommendation to submit the proposals to a general public meeting.
- v. Public Consultation will take place and the feedback from the general public will be considered in the proposals by the Recreation Committee.
- vi. Once the scheme is completed to a conceptual stage, the scheme will be submitted to the full Parish Council for approval and action on specific planning, change of use approvals or other requirements.

The Parish Council will then determine what further action is required by the Recreation Committee.
